To offer products that include 'fair trade' designation and other similar strategies aimed at quality of life for foreign workers.

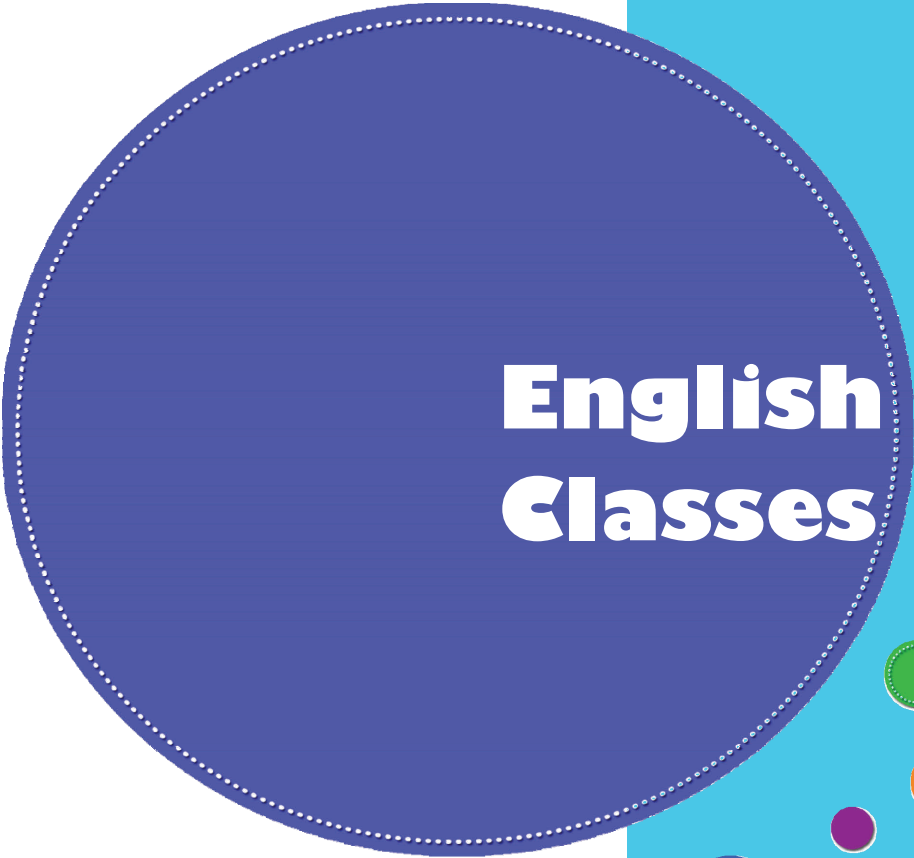

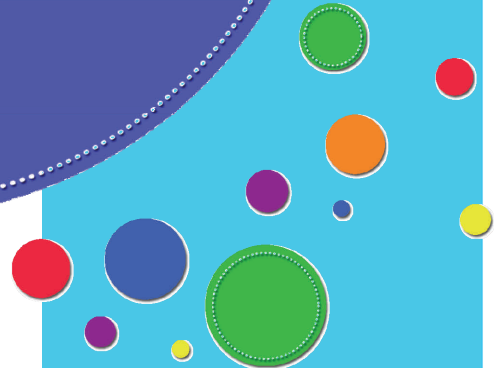
