## Jim Stier



Jim and his wife Pam pioneered the work of YWAM Brazil in 1974. They raised 5 children in Brazil and worked in many areas including orphanages, a house for babies with AIDS, help for street children, the preservation of tribal languages and cultures, and much work with the church. During the nineties Jim was the director of YWAM's Frontier Missions and the director of the work in the Portuguese world. He also served as the International Director of Evangelism and Frontier missions, a role that he still holds.

Jim served as the International President of Youth with a Mission from 1995 until 2000. At that point he took on the job of Executive Chairman of YWAM International. He served in that role until August of 2004. Currently Jim is the Director of the Americas Field for YWAM.

Leonie's passion is seeing God worshipped where He is not! Her passion and a pioneering spirit have led this Aussie on an incredible 20 year journey around the world with Youth With A Mission (YWAM) mobilizing and training His people for the fulfillment of the Great Commission. Her heart particularly beats for the people of the Himalaya; (N. India, N. Pakistan, Tibet, Nepal and Bhutan) which led her in 1995 as the Base Director of YWAM Cimarron-Colorado to pioneer "Operation Himalaya" a movement of prayer, provision and personnel that continues today to see His Name being worshipped and lives being set free at the roof top of the world. A gifted story teller and communicator, Leonie travels throughout the Body of Christ, teaching and sharing with enthusiasm the story of her God and of His transforming touch as He gathers the peoples of the world to Himself.
